Course Description

This course is designed to introduce the piano as a tool for understanding music, and develop fundamental skills for further development on the instrument.

Learning Objectives

Students will learn all 12 major scales, in both hands, before advancing to a higher level course.

Scales will be taught in this order: C, G, D, A, E, B, F#, C#, Ab, Eb, Bb, F

Required Materials

Each student is required to bring a pencil to class.

Methods of Evaluation

Student scale of progress will be tracked throughout the semester by teacher reporting.

The repertoire performance will serve as a cumulative assessment for progress in technical facility and reading.
